## Childrens Support Services & Programs

### Children's Service Coordination

Offers support services coordination to children with disabilities from birth to school graduation age (21 years) and their families in an ongoing family centered program.

### Provincial Outreach Therapy for Children

This outreach therapy program provides Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Language Therapy services within the familiar environments of the child (home or day care setting).

### Communication Centre for Children who are Deaf & Hard of Hearing

This is a family centered program that provides comprehensive interdisciplinary services to children who have a permanent conductive and/or sensori-neural hearing

## Adult Support Services & Programs

### Employment Supports & Services

SMD's Employment Preparation Centre (EPC) and Thompson Supported Employment Program (TSEP) offers employment preparation to support individual needs.

### Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)

VR involves the training, planning, preparation for and securing of gainful employment for people with disabilities entering the workforce.

### Deaf & Hard of Hearing Services

Provides a variety of services to Deaf & Hard of Hearing Manitobans.

### Financial Empowerment Programs

Develops the knowledge and skills to make financial decisions to help reach goals and build a strong financial future. We also offer access to benefits assistance and a free tax clinic.

### Ethno-Cultural Program

The Ethno-Cultural program works with children and adults who live with disabilities, whose first language is not English, helping them to navigate the health and social services systems and access available supports.



### Assistive Technology

Assistive Technology includes hearing aids, scooters, vehicle modifications, tricycles, lift chairs, specialty wheelchairs, and much more. This program provides reimbursement of up to 50% of the total cost of an assistive technology device up to a maximum of \$2,500 for SMD members.

### Community Education & Training

We provide the following workshops: Disability Awareness; The Intersection of Culture & Disability; Accessible Customer Service Standard Workshop; Deaf Culture and the Deaf Community; Inclusion in a Recreation Setting and Customized workshops based on request for

### Parking Permit Program

Provides permanent or temporary parking permits for individuals who experience difficult walking more than 50 meters

### Wheelchair Services

SMD provides manual and motorized wheelchairs suitable for the specific needs of individuals. There are currently approximately 15,000 wheelchairs on loan in Manitoba. Wheelchairs are maintained through both regularly scheduled appointments and on an emergency basis.
